(CROSS END LANE (THURLEIGH: BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO 49))

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2014

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council have made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any person driving any mechanically propelled vehicle (including motorcycles) or horse drawn vehicles along the length of Cross End Lane, Thurleigh which extends from Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 0632 5841 generally south to OS GR TL 0629 5884

This temporary closure is required to prevent further damage to the lane until weather conditions improve sufficiently to allow repairs to take place.

The closure is expected to take place from Thursday 6 February 2014 for up to six months

The above byway will remain open to pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists only.

There is no alternative Byway route for mechanically propelled vehicles.

The Order will come into operation on 6 February 2014 for a period not exceeding six months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out on or near to the Byway have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within six months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport.
