

EIN MEETING 2 FEBRUARY 2016

2015

Another busy year, teams kept the paths round the reservoir clear which needed three sessions in 2015.

Footpath from the High Street up between the side of the school and cottages to footpath 1 had major clearance work carried out which took a team of 7 several hours of hard graft.

1 extra clearance in addition the Borough Council SVC was carried out on Footpath 1.

Footpath 6 was cut back from the Church through to Scald End with 3 bridges opened up.

3 New waymark posts put in near Robins Folly on footpath 8.

Bridleway 62 cut back down to Manor Farm, which received complimentary comments from walkers on the Guided Walk by Eighth in the East.

Towards the end of the year we were asked to take on clearance work around the Memorial outside the Church for which the Parish Council have purchased us a Leaf Blower.

2016

We have been approached by the David Fowler from the now defunct Ouse Valley Ramblers who has volunteered to erect a Points of interest Notice Board in the village. This is at no cost to the village.

At present photographs of various points from which David will make a selection for an artist to illustrate the board. Suggestions of it's siting have been put forward to the Parish Council who will make the final decision.

We will otherwise continue as 2015, undertaking clearance work and putting in waymark posts and signage where required.

At the beginning of the season we will be taking possession of a second brush cutter and safety equipment courtesy of the Parish Council.
